Complaint Outcome Report #09-06 - Ethics

Early in April 2009, it came to the College's attention that a registrant had completed the online Registration Renewal Form, indicating compliance with the CDBC's Continuing Competence Program (CCP) on the Declaration of CCP Participation form. When checked against the list of registrants completing their CCP cycle in the March 31, 2009 Group, it came to light that the registrant had, in fact, missed the March 31, 2009 submission deadline and not submitted the Professional Development Plan in compliance with the registration renewal requirement.

This false declaration breached section 33 (4)(a) of the *Health Professions Act* (HPA) and section 51 (1)(e) of the CDBC bylaws which resulted in a CDBC-initiated complaint to the Inquiry Committee.

The Committee met on June 26, 2009 to review all documentation related to the complaint. In accordance with sections 33 (6)(c) and 36 (a) of the *Health Professions Act*, the registrant signed an Undertaking agreeing not to repeat making a false declaration. CDBC bylaw 62 requires this Undertaking to remain in the registrant's file for six years, until June 26, 2015.
