Inquiry Case #19-28 - Complaint Outcome Report

On **April 12, 2019**, a registrant contacted the College to report an attempt by another registrant to practice Restricted Activity A (design, compound or dispense enteral nutrition) without being registered to do so.

On **April 26, 2019**, the registrant contacted the College to discuss Restricted Activity practice while under supervision. The registrant reported that an arrangement was made with other dietitians registered to practice Restricted Activity A, to provide enteral nutrition care until the registrant became competent and safe to register and practice Restricted Activity A on her own.

On **May 16, 2019**, the Inquiry Committee met to review and discuss College correspondence with the registrant, the registrant's response and corrective actions. The Inquiry Committee determined that the registrant had breached the *Health Profession Act's* Dietitian Regulations (section 5(a)). It was determined that pursuant to sections 33(6)(c) and 36(1)(a) of the *Health Professions Act*, the registrant must undertake to "not repeat" practicing Restricted Activity A while not registered to do so.

The registrant was informed of the decision on **June 5, 2019** and signed the undertaking on **June 12, 2019**.

The complainant was notified of the decision on **June 24, 2019**.

A copy of the signed undertaking is saved in the registrant's file permanently, in accordance with section 69 of the CDDBC bylaws.

35 days were required to resolve the case.
