Inquiry Case #22-58 - Complaint Outcome Report

On **April 1, 2022**, it came to the CDBC's attention that two former registrants were marketing services with the title "Dietitian" in their online marketing, after their resignation from the College. On April 22, 2022, the former registrants were notified and advised that the Inquiry Committee would be informed of the matter. On the same day, the registrants responded that they removed the title "Dietitian" from their online marketing.

On **April 25, 2022**, the Inquiry Committee was informed of the matter and additional marketing with the title "Dietitian" was found. On April 26, the former registrant were notified. They removed all references to the title in their marketing on the same day.

On **May 31, 2022**, the Inquiry Committee met to review and discuss College correspondence with the registrant, the registrant's response and corrective actions. The Inquiry Committee determined that the registrant had breached section 12.1 of the *Health Professions Act* regarding use of the title "Dietitian" while not registered. Considering the corrective actions completed, the Committee decided to take no further action, pursuant to section 33(6)(a) of the *Health Professions Act*.

A copy of the complaint case is saved in the registrant's file permanently, in accordance with section 69 of the CDBC bylaws.

57 days were required to resolve the case.
