Inquiry Case #22-66 - Complaint Outcome Report

Between **March 7 and 13, 2023**, while completing a Continuing Competence Program (CCP) audit, it came to the College's attention that a registrant submitted a blank 2023 CCP report and had falsely declared the completion of their 2021 and 2022 CCP reports.

Between **March 13 and April 3, 2023**, the registrant provided their 2021 and 2022 CCP reports along with supporting documentation for the reports. The registrant also re-submitted their 2023 CCP report. All CCP reports met the Quality Assurance Committee's assessment criteria.

On **June 1, 2023**, the Inquiry Committee met to review and discuss College correspondence with the registrant, the registrant's response, and corrective actions. The Inquiry Committee determined that the registrant had breached sections 50(1)(e) and 58(3) of the CDBC Bylaws, regarding CCP completion, and that the risk of harm was low.

The registrant was informed of the decision on **June 2, 2023**. The registrant consented to an undertaking pursuant to sections 33(6)(c) and 36(1)(a) of the *Health Professions Act* in which the registrant agreed to not repeat false declaration of CCP completion on **June 15, 2023**.

A copy of the signed undertaking is saved in the registrant's file permanently, in accordance with section 69 of the CDBC bylaws.
