**FORM C: Candidate Application for Religious Accommodation**

A candidate who is seeking an accommodation for religious reasons must complete Form C. The accommodation must not interfere with assessing competency. CDBC must balance the rights of the candidate with its mandate to protect the public interest through a fair, secure, valid, and reliable assessment<sup>1</sup>.

CDBC will not release copies of any documentation received from the candidate related to the accommodation to any third party. CDBC collects and shares information in accordance with our privacy policies.

You are not required to share information with us but if you do not share pertinent information, we may not be able to provide the requested accommodation. Additional information and supporting documentation may be requested.

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<sup>1</sup> The Assessment for Substantial Equivalence is composed of a Knowledge Assessment and a Practical Assessment. The Knowledge Assessment is a computer-based 3-hour multiple-choice exam without a break, administered by remote proctoring in a virtual format. The Practical Assessment is a 2.5-hour virtual panel interview with case-based scenarios. The Assessments aim to confirm that candidates meet the entry-level competencies to practice safely in British Columbia.
